- Food & Beverage Manager coordinating the operations of ALL food and drink stalls run by the school, including ordering of all food and drinks items to be used on the day.

Positions Filled:

- Volunteer Coordinator coordinating ALL Volunteers for the day, including food and school stalls. (BELINDA HARRIS)
- Traffic Management in charge of the applications to RTA, traffic management liaison with external providers and car parking. (LUKE BINGHAM)
- Facebook Coordinator coordinate the Facebook page, with regular correspondence and posts. (JACQUELINE WILLIAMS)
