



Good Onya!



How

If you or your spouse volunteer 25 hours or more of your personal time over a 12 month period to work for a community organisation, CVO will make a donation of \$250 to that organisation in recognition of your contribution.

The Rules

1. To be a *Good Onya!* volunteer you must be either a Newcrest Mining CVO employee, the spouse of a Newcrest Mining CVO employee or a full time site-based contractor at CVO.
2. You must serve a minimum of 25 volunteer hours in a year to be eligible for a *Good Onya!* donation.
3. You must be able to show us how you calculated your 25 hours eg with diary entries or by providing a letter of confirmation from an executive member of the organisation you volunteered for.
4. You must not have received any personal financial benefit for volunteer hours claimed.
5. Eligible organisations include:
 - Recognised charities or disadvantaged groups (e.g. Salvation Army, Red Cross, Women's Refuge, Camp Quality, WIRES, RSPCA, etc)
 - Sporting clubs and registered associations (e.g. Blayney Netball Assoc, Orange Tennis Club, Notre Dame Softball Club, Molong Pony Club, etc)
 - Community groups (e.g. Rural Fire Brigades, Show Societies, Landcare, Guides/Scouts, CWA, etc)
 - Educational organisations (e.g. school P&C, Eisteddfod Committee, PCYC, etc). Volunteer work for educational organisations does not include assistance on school excursions.

Eligible organisations must also be based in, and servicing the community.

6. In the case of sporting clubs and associations, you must serve your volunteer hours in either a committee position or as a principal coach or team manager. Other formal roles will be considered.

Participation or playing in a team is ineligible as volunteer hours.

7. For Newcrest employees, *Good Onya!* donations are limited to one \$250 payment per person, per organisation, per annum. That means that if you work 50 hours for Camp Quality your donation is limited to \$250 for the year. However, if you work 25 hours for Camp Quality and put in another 25 hours coaching the Calare Junior Rugby team, you are eligible for 2 donations of \$250 – one to each organisation.
8. For spouses of Newcrest employees and full time site-based contractors, *Good Onya!* donations are limited to one \$250 payment per person, per annum.
9. *Good Onya!* donations are limited to eight per organisation so the maximum amount any organisation can receive is \$2,000 (8 x \$250).
10. *Good Onya!* is a calendar year program – January to December - so tally your volunteer hours from 1 January and when you reach 25, complete a *Good Onya!* application form and submit it to Alison Farrar.
