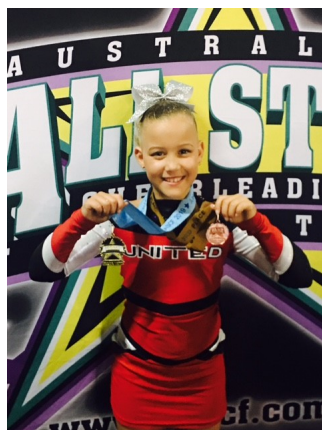

Dinner: Try our delicious vegie filled [recipes](#).

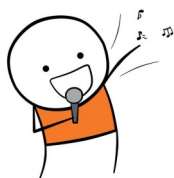
